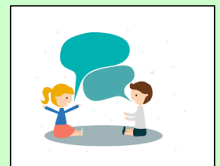
Personal, Social and Emotional Development

To be able to write their name.

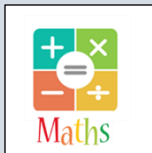
To use the correct letter formation of taught letters.

To begin to explore composition of numbers to 5 e.g. through 'bunnies' game.

To match numerals and amounts up to 5.

To find one more of numbers to 5

To find one less of numbers to 5.

Name 2D and some 3D shapes.

Understanding the World



To know that people around the world have different religions and to learn about the festival Diwali.

To know some similarities and differences between things in the past and now.

To talk about the Christmas Story and how it is celebrated.

Expressive Arts and Design

To explore different techniques for joining materials (Glue Stick, PVA, Sellotape, treasury tags, pins)



To create musical patterns using body percussion.

To use costumes and resources to act out narratives

To perform a song in the Christmas Performance

Things to keep in mind...

- Long hair should be tied back during the school day.
